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The Recipe for Sweet Fellowship Cake

During the Autumn and Fall season, we often think of recipes, good food and sweet fellowship, coming up for Thanksgiving, New Year's, and all throughout the winter months. I have combined 3 recipes, old and new, for this sweet recipe. We can serve this anytime of the

year! So, enjoy it **THIS** Thanksgiving, especially! (**Romans 16:24 ~ 24** The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.)

INGREDIENTS:

LOVE: A foundation for all recipes, add a full gallon of love: A Genuine and Unconditional Love © is the best brand. The Holy Spirit has a rich supply. He is the best source to get it from! (Additionally, have some honey (from the Rock) available to cause the mixing to be smooth and creamy.

LAUGHTER AND MERCY: Add 4 heaping, overflowing cups of Laughter, and 1 gallon of Mercy, sifted together with an abundant supply of Patience, a TBSP of Tolerance and a lb. of Thoughtfulness. Also to this, add a ½ gallon of Understanding.

HUMILITY: This is an exquisite spice; hard to come by, but adds such a sweetness to the topping. (2 cups)

KINDNESS: As much as is needed to completely oil the inside of the pot, used for baking the cake.

PATIENCE AND MEEKNESS: Mix together enough of each to be able to endure difficulties and differences with a good amount of Gentleness.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Sift together: Patience, Kindness, Meekness, Tolerance, Thoughtfulness, and Forgiveness, adding a dash of Courage, and a handful of Appreciation. Set aside. Now, mix all of the other ingredients together, reserving the Grace and Humility to be sprinkled on at the very last. Stir well, combining all ingredients. When all have been mixed well and blended together, pour into a large golden pot that is made to be placed in the oven, on the top rack. Allow the Fire of God to warm up the pot. Simmer for several hours of prayer, or until sweet to the taste. After the HG timer goes off, remove from the oven and lavishly sprinkle with Grace, and then drizzle a little more of that Unconditional Love across the top, as well as some sprinkles of Praise. The 4 Horsemen

PT 3

In our last newsletter, we left off where we were studying various words in Revelation 6:3-4. We had just looked at each of the words that stood out in the text. We will take up with that last word, SWORD. A 'Word Help' stated that one of the definitions in the Greek also meant: a dagger, mainly used for stabbing; (figuratively) an instrument for exacting retribution.

Now, we will look at the deeper meanings of these words and try to assemble a clearer, and current meaning for what we are seeing in:

Revelation 6:3-4.

3 And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

4 And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.

I will take the verses and highlight them with the Greek meanings. This will give us an idea of what these 2 verses are trying to portray. Let's put these definitions somewhat together and see what we have:

3 And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

4 And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.

- 1) And there went out another **HORSE:** GREEK: the original root is '**of uncertain derivative**', **hippopotamus**; river horse. Now, we need to look at this and think with a mind that is not satisfied with a translator, during King James' reign, who was afraid to give the real meaning of this word. Do you honestly think that a red fiery hippopotamus, carrying a rider with a sword is going to do real damage?



As I said, previously, the translators could not allow certain words or stories, into the original translations, to be put into the Bible. They greatly feared retribution from the Catholic church. The entire translation project would have been shut down!

- 2) that was **RED:** GREEK: Fire-like. Red; fiery red. Specifically flame colored
 - 3) and **POWER** was given unto him: GREEK: Vigor, Great dominion, great power, great might, great strength
 - 4) **TO TAKE:** GREEK: get a hold of with the hand, to accept and be amazed, take (away, up
 - 5) **PEACE:** GREEK: to join, peace, by implying prosperity; at one, set at one again. to join, tie together into a whole
 - 6) **FROM:** GREEK: Off, away, away from something near
 - 7) **THE EARTH:** GREEK: Earth, land, ground, soil. The original, primitive word is SOIL; a region, or the solid part or the whole of the earthly globe (including the occupants in each application).
 - 8) and that they should **KILL** one another: GREEK: To slay, to slaughter, to kill; to butcher (especially an animal for food or in sacrifice), generally) to slaughter, (specially) to maim (violently).
 - 9) and there was given unto him a **GREAT:** GREEK: Great, large, mighty; Big, mighty, sore afraid, fear exceedingly
 - 10) **SWORD:** GREEK: Conflicts, a dirk, figuratively WAR; judicial PUNISHMENT; BATTLE, i.e., controversy, fighting, to strive, striving. And this word itself was taken from a root meaning **TO WAR;** quarrel, dispute, fight.
- In case you missed the last newsletter, I will paste here, the meaning for the word, **SWORD:** *“The root of this word, SWORD, is CONFLICTS. It is translated to mean a dirk. A dirk is a type of dagger, traditionally a long, straight-bladed knife with a pointed tip, often associated with Scottish Highland culture. In criminal law, the term "dirk or dagger" is used to describe a knife or other instrument, with or without a hand guard, that is readily usable as a stabbing weapon and capable of inflicting serious injury or death. The Strong’s describes it as a knife, a dirk,”*
- So, can we see that this verse, by itself, is not a normal red horse, and that going out to make us fight each other is much more serious than just tossing a few bad words at each other? This whole thought of causing men to kill one another is a thought and a mindset of exacting punishment and death upon the other person.
- To close this study, I would like us to go to II Chronicles 20:4-22. I believe it is the answer to Revelation 6:4:
- II Chronicles 20:4-22**
- 4 And Judah gathered themselves together, to ask help of the Lord: even out of all the cities of Judah they came to seek the Lord.
 - 5 And Jehoshaphat stood in the congregation of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the Lord, before the new court,
 - 6 And said, O Lord God of our fathers, art not thou God in heaven? and rulest not thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? and in thine hand is there not power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee?
 - 7 Art not thou our God, who didst drive out the inhabitants of this land before thy people Israel, and gavest it to the seed of Abraham thy friend for ever?
 - 8 And they dwelt therein, and have built thee a sanctuary therein for thy name, saying,

- 9 If, when evil cometh upon us, as the sword, judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we stand before this house, and in thy presence, (for thy name is in this house,) and cry unto thee in our affliction, then thou wilt hear and help.
 - 10 And now, behold, the children of Ammon and Moab and mount Seir, whom thou wouldest not let Israel invade, when they came out of the land of Egypt, but they turned from them, and destroyed them not;
 - 11 Behold, I say, how they reward us, to come to cast us out of thy possession, which thou hast given us to inherit.
 - 12 O our God, wilt thou not judge them? for we have no might against this great company that cometh against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon thee.
 - 13 And all Judah stood before the Lord, with their little ones, their wives, and their children.
 - 14 Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the Spirit of the Lord in the midst of the congregation;
 - 15 And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the Lord unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's.
 - 16 Tomorrow go ye down against them: behold, they come up by the cliff of Ziz; and ye shall find them at the end of the brook, before the wilderness of Jeruel.
 - 17 Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the Lord with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the Lord will be with you.
 - 18 And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before the Lord, worshipping the Lord.
 - 19 And the Levites, of the children of the Kohathites, and of the children of the Korhites, stood up to praise the Lord God of Israel with a loud voice on high.
 - 20 And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the Lord your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.
 - 21 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the Lord, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, **Praise the Lord; for his mercy endureth for ever.**
 - 22 **And when they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.**
- No matter what the future holds, God’s Word is STILL true and it WORKS. If we will humble ourselves and turn to the Lord, as a nation, the evil which is rapidly advancing into our present, will be, and can be, pushed back.
- In closing, I would like to offer encouragement for those who love the Lord and know Him. It is found in the Book of Daniel:
- Daniel 11:32**
- 32 And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.
- That word, exploits means: to make, to do or to accomplish. WOW. Quite an array of word meanings and not all of them are exciting to look at. But this gives us a much broader insight as to what is coming in the future, maybe sooner than later. One thing definitely seems to be clear in reading this.

I think I would have to say that the rider on the red horse, has just left the stable! We will be back next time to look at the 3rd rider. Until then, Happy Thanksgiving! \ ☺ /



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The Decisions We Make

Decisions, decision, decisions. Will what you desire today take you to where God wants you to be, tomorrow? Yes, your decisions DO affect your life. Look at Abraham. Twice one week, on little things, I heard the Spirit tell me things, and I acted according to my own mind. It wasn't a matter of sin, just daily life. He said, so and so wouldn't be paying their check, but I deposited it anyway, only to have it bounce on me. I tell you: God speaks to us many times and we ignore His voice. Even in small things.

At times, if we find ourselves in a storm of life, we panic, just like the disciples. They made the wrong decision. They gave into spirits of fear during a storm, "Jesus, we're taking in water in the boat! We'll perish! Wake up! We're going to die!" How many times have you evaluated things, circumstances or people, wrongly, and then made a wrong decision?

Don't make a decision, based on the natural. Consult the Word of God first - the Mind of Christ. God sees beyond the present, and beyond your besetting demons and sins.

You see, the enemy wants to get into our decision-making process to sabotage our lives, both present and future.

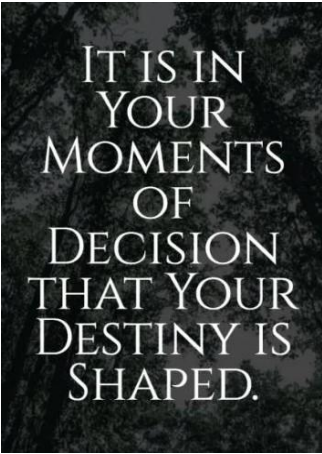
We must keep up a guard while deciding on things. Just like the enemy; he tries and often does get into most everything else. He is working to get into the decision making process, as well. You can train yourself to speak the Word over your decision making, such as:

Psalm 37:23

23 The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord: and he delighteth in his way.

Psalm 36:9

9 For with thee is the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.



You see, we are in a spiritual conflict, daily. Every area of our lives can be manipulated and invaded by evil spirits, except our born-again human spirit. The Holy Spirit lives (resides) there, and demons are not allowed to live there with the Holy Spirit.

However, this is not true for the physical body, and the soul, which is the mind, will and the emotions. So, be on guard, saints. This is war! I John 1:7

James 1:5-6

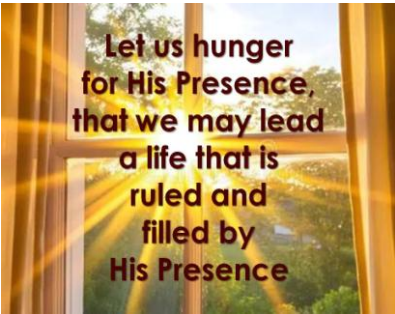
5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

The sooner we stop trying to impress others and just be ourselves in God, the sooner we can develop into who He wants us to be.

Then, we can relax and discover who we are!

Matthew 10:38-39

38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.

39 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

You, WE must lose ourselves. You must lose your life to find it. This can come through everything. We must lose the pride of trying to be impressive; to look like more than we are. Why? Because we are trying to save face, save our life, and we'll lose it. It is a divine law.

What happened to Peter?

Matthew 14:28-31

28 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.
29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.
30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

Did you see that? If you look at yourself or others, you will sink! Look at Jesus and He will help you to walk on or through anything! We must not cultivate self, but cultivate Christ. You must become absolutely honest with yourself: stop playing the part of a child.

Matthew 6:28

28 And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:
How do they grow? By being self-conscious, fussing and trying to grow and look beautiful? No! They look outside of themselves to the Son. They look upwards to the Son and their Son-Centeredness. They grow to be beautiful. You will too, as you get your eyes off you and on to Him.

The more you truly center on Him, it will have a self-revealing effect on you. It is a cleansing experience. You can see reality, not unreality.

1 Corinthians 4:1-2

1 Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.
2 Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.

You cannot serve 2 masters and be faithful to only one at the same time. You cannot serve God and self. It has been said that if we do not have within us, that which is above us, we will soon yield to that which is around us! A Dr. Blanton once said that only when we realize our own limitations, can we receive help outside ourselves. Have you come there, yet, or are you still trying to have it all together? Or, are you still trying to 'help' yourself?

Faith outside ourselves is the only answer to the tensions, anxieties, worries conflicts, sicknesses, marriage and relational difficulties and financial problems, that are making millions of lives a hell on earth!

Faith is, in reality, a form of action; it is something you exercise. You believe with a God-given gift of faith, then you must learn to exercise it!

Mark 11:22-24

22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.
23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

This is all action. New Testament faith in action. Faith is explicit, complete trust in a person: the Person of Jesus Christ! You can say, "In Christ, I am ready for ANYTHING!"

Example: There was an old, blind Indian. A person full of inner peace, revealed the source of his strength, when he said, "It is easy to believe in God, when you live alone with Him in the dark."

He knew what it was to truly exercise a real faith because spiritually, he lived with God.
Are you living locked in, alone with God, yet? They used to call this, 'Practicing the Presence of God',

Matthew 9:25

25 But when the people were put forth, he went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.

This is to say that we receive in direct proportion to the amount of faith we exercise. Be conscious of Him, every moment of every day. Practice His Presence!
